



New Brentwood Tri MyRide

Brentwood is characterized by auto-oriented, low-density development interspersed with clusters of higher density development. Brentwood is currently served by multiple infrequent, indirect, and low-ridership routes.

On-demand service may be more appropriate to serve most of Brentwood, as it allows patrons to go directly from their origin to destination within Brentwood. Tri Delta Transit's on-demand service Tri MyRide has been embraced by riders in Pittsburg, Bay Point, Oakley, and Antioch.

A new Brentwood Tri MyRide zone should be created that replaces parts of current Routes 384, 385, 395, and 202X. The Brentwood Tri MyRide zone would operate earlier and later than current bus routes and allow for better access to destinations such as the Streets of Brentwood.

The Brentwood Tri MyRide is not designed to provide regional trips and would not serve Antioch BART. Anyone wishing to travel to Antioch BART would need to transfer from Brentwood Tri MyRide to Route 373 in Brentwood or to the new Routes 375 or 377 on Lone Tree Way.
